

Tolls in Iceland

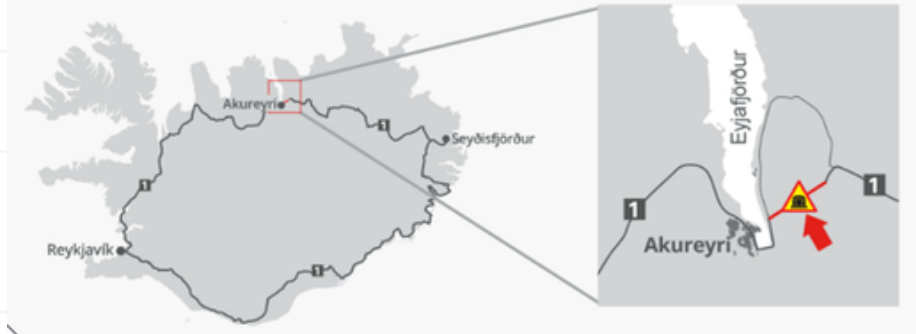


Before you begin your trip you should be aware of tolls, as this might vary throughout the destinations you want to visit.

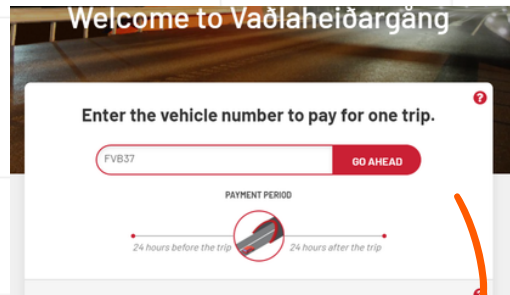
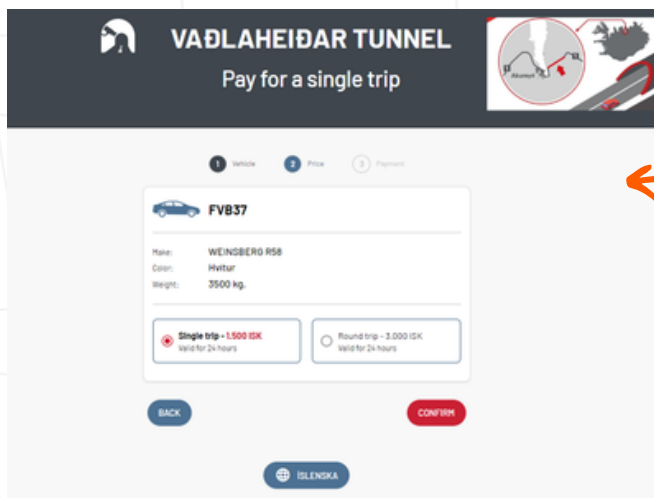
There is a place that needs to be paid once you go through it - the Vaðlaheiði tunnel in the North of Iceland. The 7.5km (4.7miles) long tunnel on the Icelandic Ring Road, allows you to save up to 12min of driving in good weather conditions.



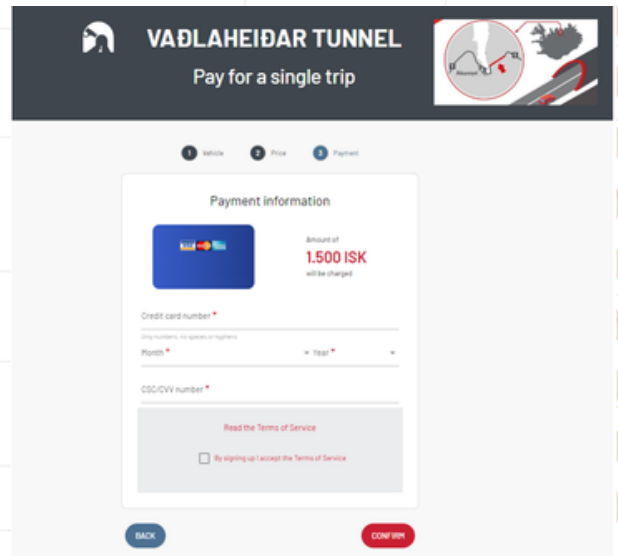
WEBSITE TO PAY



STEP 1: Open the website <https://www.veggjald.is/> and enter the vehicle plate number.



STEP 2: Select the option Single trip (valid for 24 hours)



STEP 3: The last step is just to insert the card details and make the payment.

You can pay up to 24 hours before or a maximum of 24 hours after driving through the tunnel
