Tolls in Austria

For our vehicles in Vienna, we already have a vignette.

*Please note that not all roads accept the vignette, for some roads you will have to pay the toll

Special toll rates apply on cost-intensive Alpine crossings. Special toll routes can be found on the following motorways:

- A9 Pyhrn motorway including the Bosruck and the Gleinalm tunnel
- A10 Tauern motorway including the Tauern and the Katschberg tunnel
- A11 Karawanken motorway
- A13 Brenner motorway including the Europabrücke (Europa Bridge)
- S16 Arlberg expressway including the Arlberg road tunnel

Customers who do NOT have a valid route toll authorization pay the route toll on site and place themselves in the designated dispatch lanes. Payment can be made with a variety of cards but also with cash from the toll staff.

These lanes are signposted in white with the words "Buy Ticket".





With the introduction of the vignette, these sections were exempted from the vignette obligation, i.e. section tolls segments can be used without a vignette as section tolls are paid at the toll stations.

The two most visible improvements for customers are wider drive-through lanes and the unrestricted passage on the digital route toll lanes for drivers whose vehicles have digital route toll authorization (single journeys, annual tickets, digital route toll Flex).
